

CRDB Bank Burundi s.a donates copy books and pens to support 3,000 children from families who were affected by the floods in Gatumba.

On April 19 and May 1, 2020, severe flooding affected the Gatumba area in Mutimbuzi commune of Bujumbura Rural province. These floods caused by the rising waters of the Rusizi river and Seven (7) zones of the Gatumba area (Kinyinya I, Kinyinya II, Mushasha I, Mushasha II, Muyange I, Muyange II and Gaharawe) were affected by the floods and people in those areas lost everything.

After hearing what happened, CRDB BANK could not remain silent and decided to also step in to bring assistance to those affected and especially to the most vulnerable portion: the children. Many benefactors brought food, drinking water, clothes and other much needed supplies. Our support intervenes in the field of education by focusing on the children's return to school which will take place in September 2020.

The modest package includes 15,000 copy books and 6,000 pens and the total value of these items cost more than BIF 35 Million.
